**Position:** Landscaper

Job Class: Full-time, Non-exempt

**Job Summary:** This position reports directly to the Director of Facilities Maintenance.

## Core duties and responsibilities

• Person performs a variety of skilled, semi-skilled, and unskilled tasks in the maintenance and upkeep of the buildings and grounds of Historic Deerfield.

- Work includes but is not limited to trash pickup, events setups, changing light bulbs, leaf removal, snow removal, dog waste station removal, maintenance of tools, and equipment.
- Lawn mowing, shrub pruning, minor tree work.
- Remove and install heavy glass cabinet doors.
- Install, move, reinstall office furniture, tables, chairs and display cabinets etc.
- Cautiously moving equipment, supplies, materials and furniture throughout the museums.
- Cut and process firewood for Hearth cooking.
- Tree removal and cleanup.
- Remove and replace window AC's, storm windows and screens
- Exterior building including gutter cleaning, washing walls, window well cleaning.
- Handles wild animal calls the best as possible.
- Must be able and willing to:
  - Interact with other employees and guests of Historic Deerfield.
  - o Be able to work from ladder and roofs when needed.
  - Do extra tasks including assisting other trades.
  - Plow, shovel and snow blow. Must be willing to work off hours and weekends for snow removal and other emergencies.
  - Heavy lifting.
  - Assist with tree removal and wood processing
  - Assist in any way if capable of doing so if directed by the Director of Facilities and Maintenance.
  - Ability to work in extreme weather conditions.
  - Ability to run a backhoe
- Must be knowledgeable of/in:
  - Operate a tractor as needed.
  - Operate Mowers, chainsaws, weed trimmers, hedge clippers and various lawn care care equipment.
  - Plowing and snow blowing.
  - Must have a valid Mass. Driver's license.

**Hours:** Typical work hours are 7AM to 3PM Monday through Friday. Weekend shifts may be required. This position is on call 24/7 for emergencies that may arise and for snow removal.
